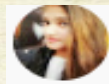

GRAMMAR TRICKS BASED ON VERB

After many/a great many/a good many, etc., the noun is always plural, which is followed by a plural verb.

A great many girls are following fashion trends these days.



GRAMMAR TRICKS BASED ON VERB

**After 'a number of/a large number',
the noun and verb in the sentence
are always plural.**

**A number of soldiers have lost their
lives on the border.**



GRAMMAR TRICKS BASED ON VERB

After 'the number', the noun is plural but the verb is singular.

The number of soldiers at the border is large.

No sooner had, hardly had, scarcely had, etc. are the adverbials that require a past perfect tense and a past indefinite tense for the sentence.

No sooner had I reached home than she left.

Scarcely had the police reached when the man died.

GRAMMAR TRICKS BASED ON VERB

The clause 'it is time' or 'it is high time' requires a verb in the simple past if there is a clause after it.

It is high time you studied attentively.

It is time to study attentively. (You can replace the clause by an infinitive removing the subject)

To is the only preposition that takes the base form of the verb. However, there are some phrases with to being at the end of them, which require the gerund form of the verbs.

With a view to, look forward to, being accustomed to, being used to, admit to, confessed to

He went there with a view to confessing his crimes.

I am looking forward to meeting the princess.

To be, being, having, getting, etc. are generally followed by the past participle form of the verbs and other adjectives.

Being tired, he took some time off from work.

He became astonished being robbed in the daylight.

John went to bazar having eaten a burger.

He wanted to be educated.
