








<u>Definition</u> 1) to change direction or make something change direction especially after hitting something







Definition the pleasant state of feeling lazy and without energy




Trigger

Usage Suddenly the car accelerated.




Dexterous

<u>Usage</u> As people grow older they generally become less dexterous









<u>Definition</u> an opinion or idea that is not based on definite knowledge and is formed by guessing




