of three cows in Sukhet village in Jhanjharpur block of Madhubani district in Bihar.

Earlier, most of Munni Devi's time was spent over an earthen stove in a corner of her house. Fired with wood, crop waste and cow dung, the stove **billowed noxious** smoke into the house, leaving her ill and breathless. Every month she had to consult a local doctor for huffani (breathing) trouble. Rampari Devi, in her sixties, and her daughter-in-law Lalo Devi too had similar stories of ill-health and visits to doctors. Though they had LPG connections, the rising cost of refills put

the cleaner cooking fuel out of reach.




