Antonyms: clumsy

Example Sentence: The script was both deft and literate.

2. **ACCREDIT (VERB)** : (अधिकृत करना) : recognize

Synonyms: license, authorize

Antonyms: ban

Example Sentence: Institutions that do not meet the standards will not be accredited for teacher training.

3. **PRUDENCE (NOUN)** : (बुद्धिमत्ता) : wisdom

Synonyms: judgement, sagacity

Antonyms: folly

Example Sentence: We need to exercise prudence in such important matters.
