1. VOLATILE (ADJECTIVE) : (परिवर्तनशील) : unpredictable Synonyms: changeable, variable Antonyms: stable Example Sentence: He is a passionate, volatile young man.

2. DEFY (VERB) : (अवज्ञा करना) : disobey Synonyms: go against, flout Antonyms: obey Example Sentence: A woman who defies convention is considered amoral.

3. SUCCOUR (VERB) : (सहायता करना) : help Synonyms: aid, assist Antonyms: hinder Example Sentence: Prisoners of war were liberated and succoured.

ADJECTIVE (विशेषण)

Definition :- It is used to show the quality of NOUN or PRONOUN in the sentences.

Eg :- 1) Aman is a powerful man. 2) They are very courageous.

Degree of Comparison :-

Positive Degree One syllabic word More syllabic word More syllabic dood Bad Little

Comparative Degree Greater Sharper More Powerful More Dangerous Better Worse Less

Superlative Degree Greatest Sharpest Most Powerful Most Dangerous Best Worst Least



Basic conditions of Adjective :-

(1) Use of Little/Few :- Little is used for uncountable noun & Few is used for countable noun.

Little :- (1) Little (-ve sense) (2) A Little (+ve sense) (3) The Little (All sense)

Eg :- (1) I have little money left in my pocket so I cannot buy this article. (2) I have a little money left in my pocket, only two of us can

go for a picnic.

(3) The little money left in my pocket must not be spent anymore.

Few :- (1) Few (-ve sense) (2) A Few (+ve sense) (3) The Few (All sense)

Eg :- (1) There are few students present in the class so we will have to postpone the class for tomorrow.

(2) There are a few students that got selection in this company.

(3) I have met the few students in Agra and I am in with all of them.

(2) We have to use Adj (same degree) with 'AND' :-

Eg :- (1) Rahul is a good and intelligent student.
(2) Sonu is better and smarter than Rahul for this project.

(3) Use article 'THE' with 'WHOLE' in the sent. :-

Eg :- (1) The whole team is doing practice for this tournament.
 (2) The whole world is facing a very tough time because of CORONA.

⇒ Use of Degree :-

(1) Positive Degree :- It used to show the quality of Noun and Pronoun.

Eg :- (1) Priyanka is a very good and intelligent girl.(2) He is a very handsome guy.

Formation for Positive Degree :-

(P1) :- SUB(1) + HV/MV + as/so + Post. Deg. + as + SUB(2) SO/AS :- for showing -ve sense. AS :- for showing +ve sense.

> Eg :- (1) Aman is as intelligent as karan. (2) Radhika is not so beautiful as Preeti.

(P2) :- No other + SUB(1) (sing.) + HV/MV + as/so + Post. Deg. + as + SUB(2)

Eg :- (1) No other Policy is so helpful as Jeevan Anand policy.
(2) No other Employee is as good as Anmol in marketing.

(P3) :- Very Few + SUB(1) (plu.) + HV/MV + as/so + Post. Deg. + as + SUB(2)

Eg :- (1) Very few Cricketers are so famous as Sachin Tendulkar.
(2) Very few Members are as honest as Mukesh in this club.
