- 1)QUALITATIVE ADJECTIVE**
- 2)QUANTITATIVE ADJECTIVE**
- 3)NUMERAL ADJECTIVE**

- 1) POSITIVE DEGREE***
- 2) COMPARATIVE DEGREE***
- 3) SUPERLATIVE DEGREE***

## USE OF SOME COMMON ADJECTIVES

1) **SOME** – used in positive sentences .

**NOTE:** It can be used to ask negative questions.

2) **ANY**- used in negative sentences .

3) **LITTLE / FEW** – almost negligible or zero . Conveys **NEGATIVE** sense.

4) **A LITTLE /A FEW** – some.

5) **THE LITTLE/THE FEW** – not sufficient but all there is .

**BOTH “A LITTLE & THE LITTLE “** conveys **POSITIVE SENSE**.

6) **FURTHER**- additional information

7) **FARTHER**- additional distance
