⇒ Vocab of the day :-

1. **LAX (ADJECTIVE)** : (लापरवाह) : **slack**

Synonyms: slipshod, negligent

Antonyms: stern

Example Sentence: We must ever be lax with our security.

2. **REPRIEVE (VERB)** : (दंड निलंबित करना) : **pardon**

Synonyms: spare, acquit

Antonyms: charge

Example Sentence: He was sentenced to death but then reprieved.

3. **DEFECTION (NOUN)** : (पक्षत्याग) : **desertion**

Synonyms: absconding, decamping

Antonyms: joining

Example Sentence: One defection from the government dissolved Temaru's majority.
