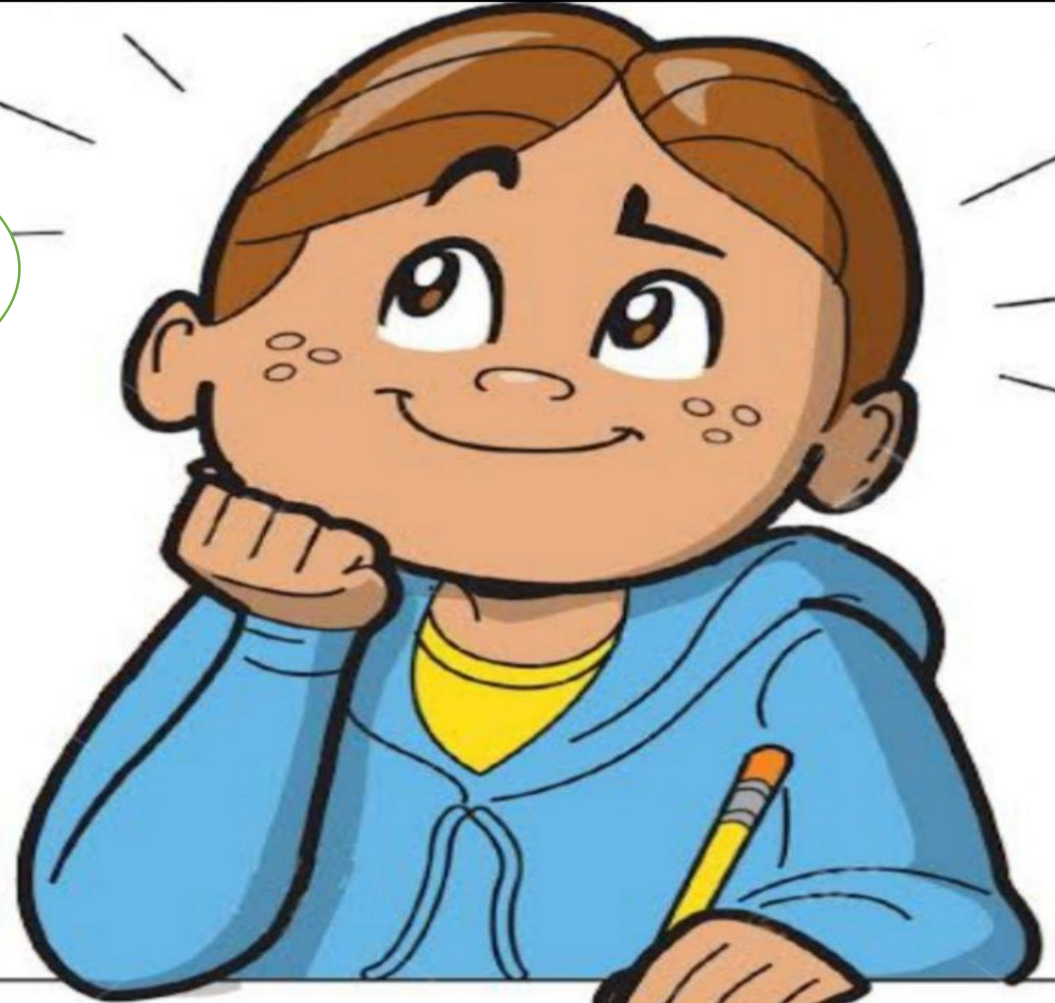

## **A /AN ARTICLE**

### **RULE – 1**

***The choice between 'a' and 'an' is determined by sound.***

<b>An:</b>	<b><i>Before a word beginning with a vowel sound.</i></b>
<b>A:</b>	<b><i>Before a word beginning with a consonant sound .</i></b>



- 1) I have (a) / been informed that (b) / Mr. Gupta , the M.D and the C.E.O (c) / will visit Pune the following month . (d) / no error (e)
- 2) It was (a) / by a mistake (b) / that she caught (c) / his hand .(d) / no error (e)

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## RULE-2

*When "THE Article " is used before and after " AND " then it denotes TWO different persons and when it is used once before "AND " , then it denotes ONLY ONE PERSON with TWO designations .*

## RULE -3

*With some phrases "THE Article " is always used –  
On the /at the corner of , walk down the street, on the phone , the whole day , speak the truth , what is the problem , what is the matter , take the day off .*

## RULE -4

*With two different subjects always use two articles separately .*
