=> <u>Vocab of the day</u> :-

1. TORMENT (NOUN) : (यातना) : agony

Synonyms: suffering, torture Antonyms: pleasure Example Sentence: Their deaths have left both families in torment.


2. SOUR (ADJECTIVE) : (चिड़चिड़ा) : nasty Synonyms: resentful, embittered

Antonyms: pleasant Example Sentence: He gave her a sour look.

3. THWART (VERB) : (विफल करना) : foil

Synonyms: frustrate, balk Antonyms: assist Example Sentence: She did all she could to thwart his plans.





NOTE :- Article "A" or "AN" are followed by the sound of the vowels, not the words in the sentences.



RULE (1) <u>A/AN</u> + <u>Verb</u> (Treated as a Noun) :-

Eg :- 1) My father goes for a walk daily.2) I saw a play in my colony yesterday.

RULE (2) <u>A/AN</u> + <u>Some Idiom & Phrase</u> :-

Eg :- A white elephant, An apple of eye, A sitting duck.....

RULE (3) If singular noun is placed after many, such, quite, rather, how etc., we use 'A' before that noun :-

Eg :- 1) I have never seen such a girl in my life.2) Many a country is with India against corruption.

RULE (4) If these words are used in singular, we use 'A' before them; Noise, Lie, Hole, Headache (words ending in ache), commotion etc.

Eg :- 1) The student makes a noise in the class.2) He was telling a lie in the meeting.

RULE (5) Article (a/an) is not used after kind of, sort of, type of, variety of :-

Eg :- 1) What variety of a guava is this? (Incorrect) ⇒ What variety of guava is this? (Correct)

<u>Condition of Zero Article</u> :- There are some conditions in which we don't use any article in the sentences.

Cond. (1) With the name of Games.

Eg :- Cricket, Hockey, Football, Kabbadi, Kho-Kho & so on.....

Cond. (2) With the name of Peak of the Mountain. Eg :- Mount Everest, K2.....

Cond. (3) With the name of Festivals. Eg :- Diwali, Holi, Christmas, Id, Easter, New year.....

Cond. (4) With the name of Meals.

Eg :- Lunch, Breakfast, Dinner, Brunch, Supper.....

Cond. (5) With the name of states except (The Punjab). Eg :- Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh, Gujrat, Karnataka & so on.....

Cond. (6) With the name of Capital of Nation & States . Eg :- New Delhi, Tokyo, Chandigarh, Gandhi Nagar & so on......

Cond. (7) With the name of Famous Brands. Eg :- Puma, Fastrack, Woodland, Lakme, & so on......

Cond. (8) With the name of Small Designations. Eg :- Driver, Guard, Chef, Peon & so on.....

Cond. (9) With the name of Langauge. Eg :- French, German, Hindi, English & so on......

Cond. (10) Article can't be used with universal fact. Eg :- 1)Man is mortal. 2) Honesty is best policy.

Cond. (11) Article can't be used with the given verbs . <u>Verbs</u> :- Elect, Appoint, Select, Nominate, Make Eg :- 1) He selected me President of this society. 2) Ramesh is appointed Manager in this company.

Cond. (12) Article can't be used before certain phrase. Eg :- In morning, In hand, In prison, At afternoon, In evening, At night & so on.....
