Tips & Tricks



- 1. Check the links:** There is always something connecting either in the context or in the flow of the sentence. Usually, it is a particular theme and you can identify.



2. Nouns and pronouns reference: Nouns or subjects mentioned in a statement can be replaced by a pronoun in the next statement. Be always on the lookout for such pairs.




3. Subject matching: two statements based on the subject form a pair
