Types of Conjunctions

- **Coordinating Conjunctions**
- **Correlative Conjunctions**
- **Subordinating Conjunctions**



After the adverbs "Hardly / Scarcely", the conjunction 'when or before' should be used.

- o Hardly had he left the place than the Bomb exploded. X
- o Hardly had he left the place when the Bomb exploded.✓



After the subordinating conjunction 'lest' the auxiliary 'should' is used.

Lest - for fear that / If it is not so.

- o Work hard lest you fail. X
- o Work hard lest you should fail.✓



The conjunction 'or' is used with not / never.

- o I have never spoken to him nor written to him. X
- o I have never spoken to him or written to him.✓



The connecting word 'that' is used with the adjective phrase 'the same/the only/superlative adjectives/all

- o This is the same book which I wanted. X
- o This is the same book that I wanted. ✓
