SUBJECT-VERB AGREEMENT



Basic Rule.

A singular subject (she, Bill, car) takes a singular verb (is, goes, shines), whereas a plural subject takes a plural verb.

Example:

The list of items ~~is/are~~ on the desk.

If you know that list is the subject, then you will choose is for the verb.



SUBJECT-VERB AGREEMENT

ear
Sub(1) + of + Sub(2)

A subject will come before a phrase beginning with of.

This is a key rule for understanding subjects.

Singular

Incorrect:

A bouquet of yellow roses lend color and fragrance to the room.

Plural

Singular

lends

Correct:

A bouquet of yellow roses lends .

Plural

(bouquet lends, not roses lend)

SUBJECT-VERB AGREEMENT

Sometimes the subject is separated from the verb by such words as along with, as well as, besides etc. In this case use the verb according to first subject.

Singular

Plural

Examples:

The politician, along with the newsmen, is expected shortly.

Excitement, as well as nervousness, is the cause of her shaking.

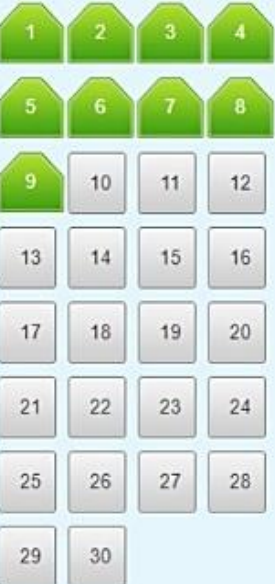
