2. **CONVALESCE (VERB)** : (अच्छा हो जाना) : recuperate

Synonyms: recover, improve

Antonyms: deteriorate

Example Sentence: He spent eight months convalescing after the stroke.

3. **UNWAVERING (ADJECTIVE)** : (स्थिर) : steady

Synonyms: fixed resolute

Antonyms: unsteady

Example Sentence: She fixed him with an unwavering stare.
