

CONJUNCTION works like a CONNECTOR.





CO-ORDINATING CONJUNCTIONS

Conjunctions which are used to join together clauses of equal rank are known as Co-ordinate Conjunctions.

SUBORDINATING CONJUNCTIONS:

Conjunctions which are used to join clauses of unequal rank are known as Subordinating Conjunctions or a Principal Clause with a Sub-ordinate Clause or an Independent Clause with a Dependent Clause.

Group of words which are used as conjunctions are known as Compound Conjunctions.
