



(Object).—Passive Voice






ACTIVE & PASSIVE VOICE

Rules to Changing Voice:

- a) <u>Subject should be placed in place of Object and object</u> should be in place of Subject
- b) "By" is used with a noun or a pronoun for showing doer
- c) We can change voice of only a <u>transitive verb</u> that is a verb with an object
- d) We can't change voice of an intransitive verb that is a verb without an object









































In Present perfect continuous tense, Past perfect continuous tense, Future perfect continuous tense, Future perfect tense, we use the same sentence in passive voice. It means these tense cannot be changed in passive form.








