- 4) Always Compare SIMILAR QUALITIES while using COMPARATIVES .

# *RULES*

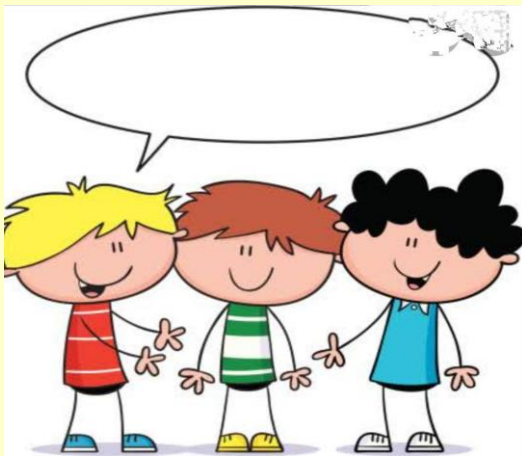
- 8) Double COMPARATIVES are never used for comparing only one QUALITY of a NOUN / a PRONOUN .
- 9) Each – represents individuality .
- 10) Each and Every + singular noun + singular helping verb .
- 11) a) Later- afterwards .  
b) Latest – modern / current .  
c) Latter – second part which is last part of something .  
d) Last – nth part of something .
