

No use of article is there after 'what kind of' and 'what sort of', 'what type of' 'what variety of'.

Examples :-

What kind of a boy he is

What sort of a novel it is

'The' is used before the name of commission. Example –

The Simon commission is still functioning.
The election commission is still counting the votes.

If two proper nouns are compared we use definite article before the last proper noun

Example :----

i) Sachin is the Lara of India.
ii) Kalidas is the Shakespeare of India.
iii) Mumbai is the London of india .
iv) Abdul kalam is the newton of our country .

It must be used before superlative degree Example –

- Rohit is the tallest boy of his school.
 BUT—
- Shivam is the tallest and best boy of his school.
- This is the highest building in the new York .

A' is used before some indefinite numbers. Like :A lot of
A number of
A half of
A great deal of
A large number of
A quarter of

<u>A large number</u> of people gathered in a hall.
 <u>A great deal</u> of sugarcane products was done by them.

<u>A half of the voters have not made up their minds</u>

' A' can be used before some indefinite collective numbers. Like

- A gang of
- A team of
- A flock of
- A swarm of
- A bunch of
- A herd of
- A panel
- A pride of , etc.

*A group of people was discussing about the accident .

To make a common noun of a proper noun.

A Sherlock is living in my neighbourhood .
 You are like a salman khan .

[like that person not that person].
