#### TRICK 1

If two actions take place one after the other in future, and if the second depends on the first action, the first action is in simple present tense and second action is in simple future tense.



- A. She will come to meet you as soon as you will reach Delhi.
- B. If the government will become strict, corruption will surely finish.

If a probability is expressed in a sentence, may/might shall be used in place of "will".



- A. If it rains, the students may not come for class.
- B. If the fog stays for long, the flights will get late.

#### **TRICK 3**

If the sentence is related to a suggestion, 'should / must' will be used in place of 'will'.



- A. If you want to remain healthy, you will exercise daily.
- B. If you do not know him, you must not open the door.
