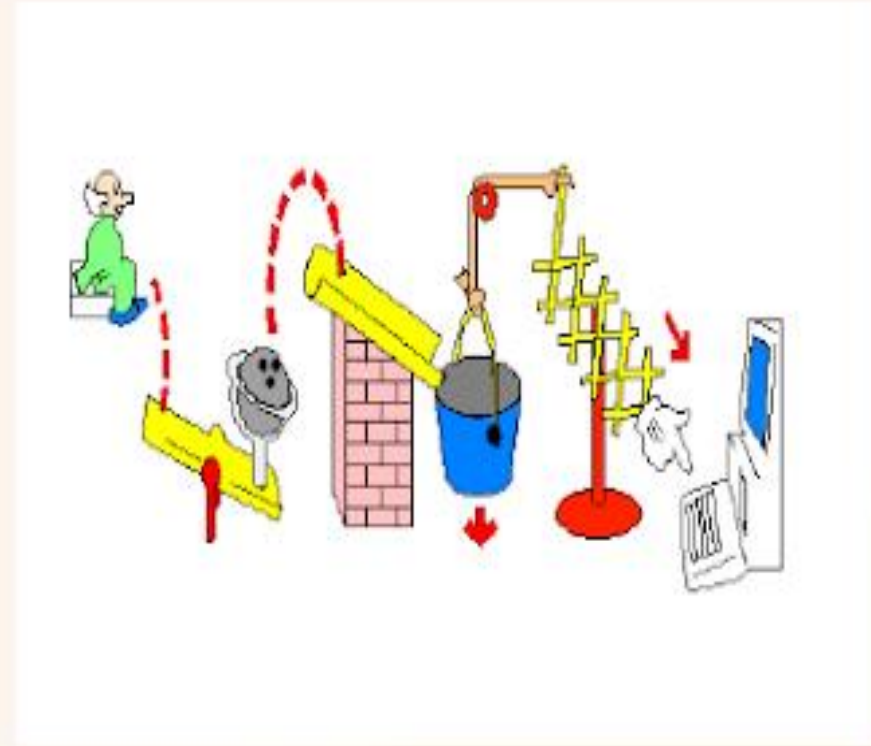


## Unfledged
