Meaning : A situation in which neither side in an argument or contest can win or in which no progress is possible

Synonyms: Impasse , Deadlock

Confront(Verb) : सामना करना

Meaning : To face especially in challenge : oppose

Sentence : She was confronted with severe money problems.

Aldermen(Noun)

Meaning : One of the senior members of a local council,
elected by other councilors

Sentence : The town was incorporated in 1899, and the
corporation consists of a mayor, 6 aldermen and 18
councillors.

Alleged(Adj.) : आरोपित

Meaning : Accused but not proven or convicted

Synonyms : Purported , Declared

Antonyms : Actual

Sentence: It was alleged that the policeman had accepted bribes.

Bureaucracy(Noun) : कर्मचारी शासन

Meaning : Refers to a body of non-elected governing officials as well as to an administrative policy-making group

Synonyms : Administration

Sentence: The changes were supposed to reduce bureaucracy but the opposite has happened.


Ambiguity(Noun) : दुविधापूर्णता

Meaning : Doubtfulness or uncertainty of meaning or intention

Synonyms : Vagueness , Dubiety

Antonyms : Clarity , Certainty

Sentence : The ambiguity begins to disappear as more explanations are made.



Dispelled(Verb) : दूर हो जाना ✓

Meaning : To remove fears, doubts, or false ideas,
usually by proving them wrong or unnecessary ✓

Synonyms : Eliminate , Banish ✓

Antonyms : Collect , Gather ✓

Sentence : We need to dispel the myths and establish
real facts. ✓

Barbarity(Noun): क्रूरता

Meaning : Extremely cruel and violent behavior

Synonyms : Brutality , Atrocity

Antonyms : Humanity

Sentence: He is accused of inflicting unimaginable barbarities on his own people.

Ousted : बेदखल

Meaning : To force someone to leave a position of power, job, place, or competition

Synonyms : Fired , Expel

Antonyms : Admitted

Sentence: The president was ousted (from power) in a military coup in January 1987.
