

'Muslim girl above 15 years can marry'

High Court cites Muslim personal law






The Punjab and Haryana High Court has held that a Muslim girl above 15 years of age is competent to enter into a contract of marriage with a person of her choice. Justice Jasjit Singh Bedi's assertion came during a petition filed by a Muslim couple, who fell in love and solemnized their marriage on June 6, 2022, as per Muslim rites and ceremonies. Both the petitioners in Punjab's Pathankot had approached the High Court seeking protection of life and liberty from the respondents, including family members. Pointing out that the marriage of a Muslim girl is governed by the Muslim personal law, Justice Singh stated, "... As per Article 195 from the book Principles of Mohammeden Law by Sir Din shah Fardunji Mulla, the petitioner No. 2 (girl) being over 16 years of age was competent to enter into a contract of marriage with a person of her choice.









Address apprehension


"...The court cannot shut its eyes to the fact that the apprehension of the petitioners needs to be addressed. Merely because the petitioners have got married against the wishes of their family members, they cannot possibly be deprived of the fundamental rights," Justice Singh said.
