



Marred(Verb) : बिगाड़ देना

Meaning : To harm or damage something good

Synonyms: Spoil , Ruin

Antonyms : Improve

Sentence: There were at least three different footprints but they were marred and nearly indistinguishable.

Enmity(Noun) : शत्रुता

Meaning : A feeling of hostility or ill will, as between enemies
