

Scientists set new record in nuclear fusion energy



ARTICLE

Scientists in the United Kingdom said they had achieved a new **milestone** in producing nuclear fusion energy, or **imitating** the way energy is produced in the sun. Energy by nuclear fusion is one of mankind's **long standing quests** as it promises to be low carbon, safer than how nuclear energy is now produced and, with an **efficiency** that can technically exceed a 100%. A team at the Joint European Torus (JET) facility near Oxford in central England generated 59 mega joules of **sustained** energy during an experiment in December, more than doubling a 1997 record, the U.K. Atomic Energy Authority said in a statement. A kilogram of fusion fuel contains about 10 million times as much energy as a kilogram of coal, oil or gas. The energy was produced in a machine called a tokamak, a doughnut-shaped **apparatus**.

Deuterium and tritium, which are isotopes of hydrogen, are heated to temperatures 10 times hotter than the centre of the sun to create plasma. This is held in place using superconductor electromagnets as it **spins around**, fuses and releases **tremendous** energy as heat. The record and scientific data from these **crucial** experiments are a major boost for the ITER, the larger and more advanced version of the JET. The ITER is a fusion research mega-project supported by seven members China, the European Union, India, Japan, South Korea, Russia and the U.S. and based in the south of France. It seeks to further **demonstrate** the scientific and technological **feasibility** of fusion energy.

Ian Chapman, CEO, U.K. Atomic Energy Authority, said in a statement: “These **landmark results** have taken us a huge step closer to **conquering** one of the biggest scientific and engineering challenges of them all. It is reward for over 20 years of research and experiments with our partners from across Europe...”

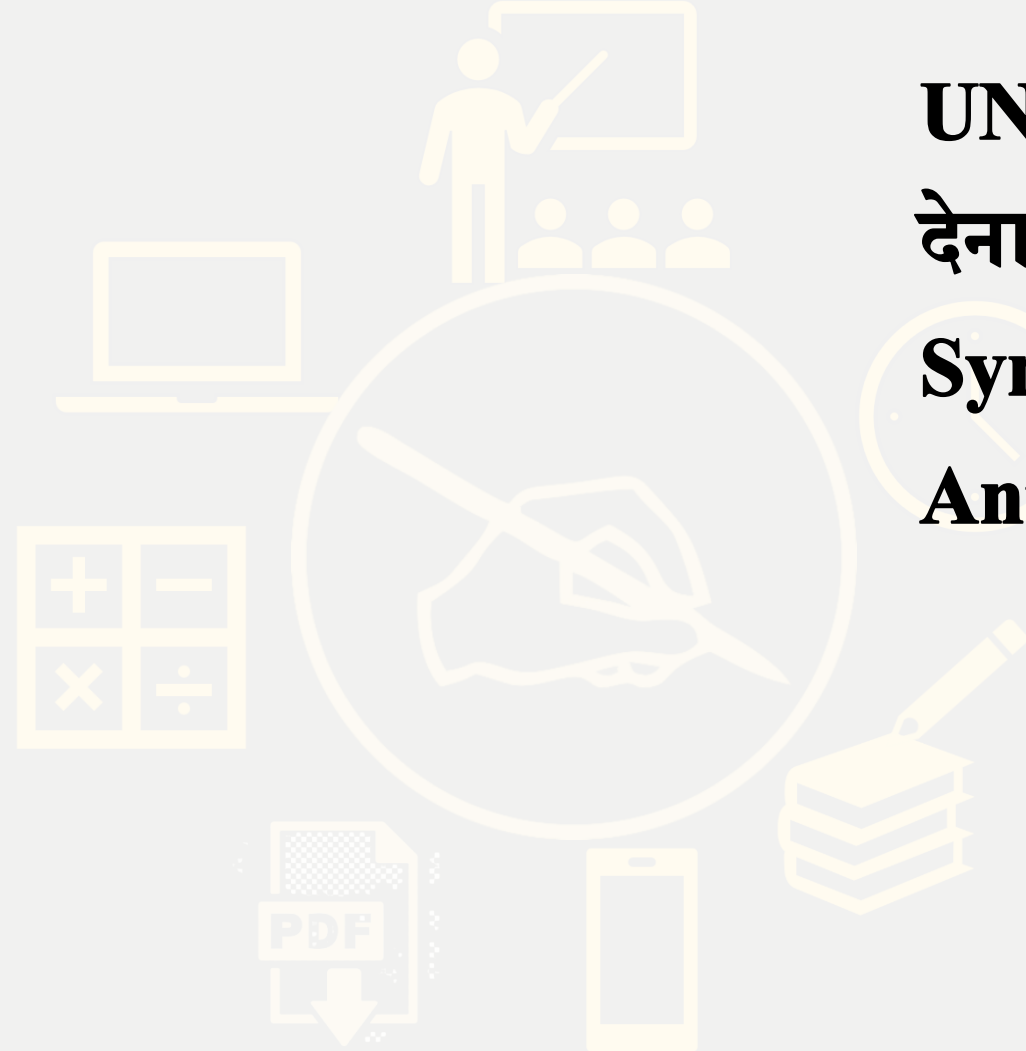


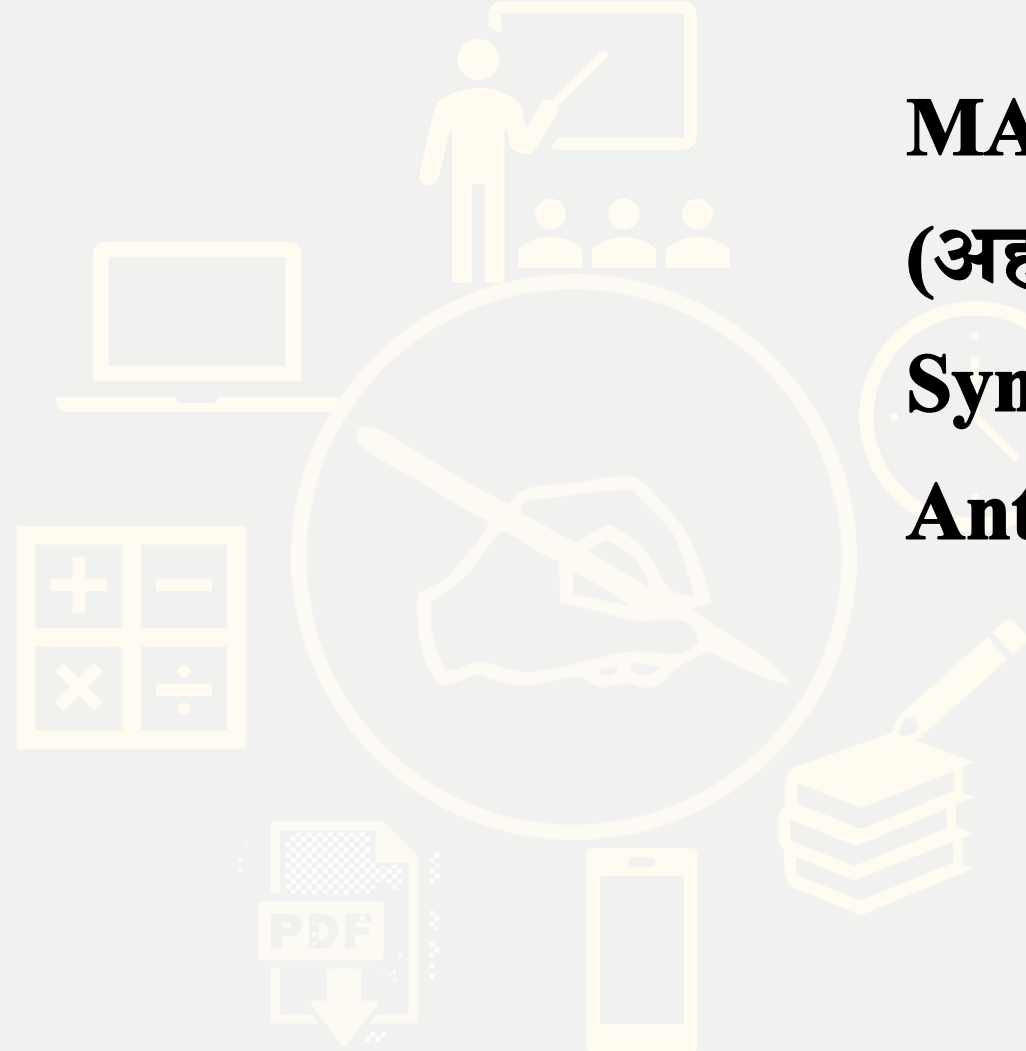

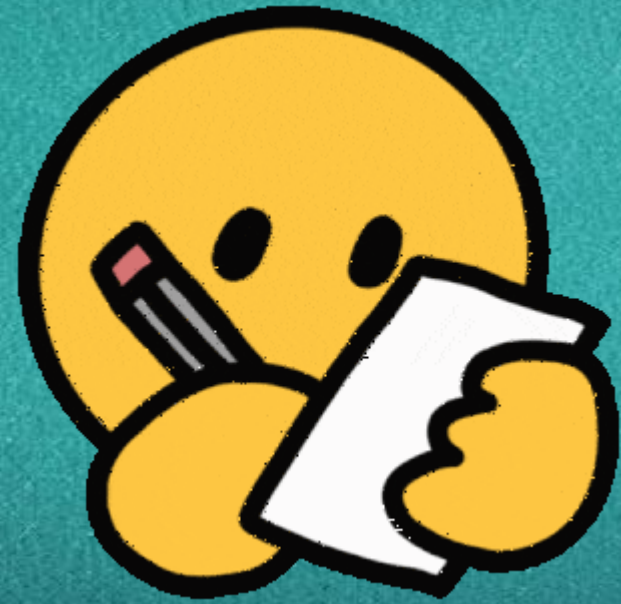
