Surfeit(Noun) : आधिक्य

Meaning : An overabundant supply : excess

Synonyms: Superfluity , Avalanche

Antonyms: Lack , Dearth

Sentence: We had such a surfeit of food during the holidays that we gave a large portion of it to the family across the street.

Patriarchy(Noun) : पितृसत्ता

Meaning : A social system in which positions of dominance and privilege are primarily held by men.

Synonyms : Masculinity , Hegemonic

Antonyms : Matriarchy

Sentence: For over a hundred years the country has been ruled through the patriarchy of kings.

Manoeuvre(Noun) : कपट-प्रयोग

Meaning : A tactic or movement of one or a number of military or naval units

Synonyms : Manipulate , Intrigue

Antonyms : Cessation , Honesty

Sentence : I manoeuvred my way among the tables to the back corner of the place.

Dissidence(Noun) : मतभेद

Meaning : Disagreement

Synonyms: Discord , Disapproval

Antonyms: Acceptance, Agreement

Sentence : She argued in her dissent that Congress
had exceeded its authority.

Whip(Noun) : कोड़ा

Meaning : To beat with a strap, lash, rod

Synonyms: Belt , Flog

Sentence: The cruel man lashed the horse with his whip.

Jostling(Verb) : धक्का मुक्की

Meaning : Being bumped and pushed in a horde of people

Synonyms: Scramble , Shove

Antonyms: Abstain

Sentence: We spent an hour jostling with the crowds as we did our shopping.

Lustre(Noun) : चमक

Meaning : A very special, attractive quality that people admire

Synonyms: Sheen , Radiance

Antonyms: Dullness , Darkness

Sentence: It was certainly a doubtful charm, imparting a hard, metallic lustre to the child's character.
