Meaning : Criticism, opposition.

Synonyms : Hostility , Obloquy

Antonyms : Approval , Compliment

Sentence : He caught heavy flak for his decision to oppose the new school.

Vicinity(Noun) : आस-पास

Meaning : A surrounding area or district

Synonyms: Locality , Neighbourhood

Antonyms: Distance , Remoteness

Sentence : There are several hotels in the immediate vicinity of the station.

Inundation(Noun) : बाढ़

Meaning : The condition or state of being overwhelmed

Synonyms: Overflow , Deluge

Sentence: Her office was inundated with requests for tickets.

Spared : क्षमा करना

Meaning : To not hurt or destroy something or someone

Synonyms: Absolved , Clear

Antonyms: Generous , Lavish

Sentence: Prisoners are spared the indignity of wearing uniforms.
