Irrevocably(Adverb) : अटल रूप से

Meaning : Not able to be revoked, changed, or undone

Synonyms: Fixed , Unchangeable

Antonyms : Bare , Open

Sentence: Stealing from a friend may cause you to irrevocably damage that friendship.

Dossier(Noun) : फ़ाइल

Meaning : A file containing detailed records on a particular person or subject

Synonyms : Casebook , Summary

Sentence: The company is compiling a dossier of evidence to back its allegations.

Pertains(Verb) : संबद्ध होना

Meaning : To have reference, relation, or relevance.

Synonyms : Concern , Associate

Antonyms : Irrelevant , Immaterial

**Sentence : It was a list of questions, all of them
apparently pertaining to her mental health.**

Bait(Noun) : प्रलोभन

Meaning : Something that is used for persuading or attracting somebody

Synonyms: Lure , Goad

Antonyms: Repel , Discourage

Sentence : We put down some poisoned bait to kill the rats.

Invigorating(Adj.) : मज़बूत करना

Meaning : To give new energy or strength to someone or something

Synonyms: Energize , Rejuvenate
