

'Delhi's PM2.5 levels worst in the world

Kolkata placed second; study says Indian cities witness high PM emissions, but low NO2 emissions




Gasping for air: Motorist and pedestrian travelling amid heavy smog conditions in New Delhi. ■ FILE PHOTO

A global analysis of air quality found that Indian cities, while recording particulate matter emissions (PM2.5) that are among the highest in the world, do relatively better on nitrogen dioxide (NO2) emissions. The report, Air Quality and Health in Cities, released by U.S.based Health Effects Institute, analyses pollution and global health effects for more than 7,000 cities around the world, focusing on two of the most harmful pollutants fine particulate matter (PM2.5) and nitrogen dioxide (NO2). The report, using data from 2010 to 2019, found that global patterns for exposures to the two key air pollutants were "strikingly different." While exposures to PM2.5 pollution tend to be higher in cities located in low and middle income countries, exposure to NO2 is high across cities in highincome as well as low and middle income countries.






