

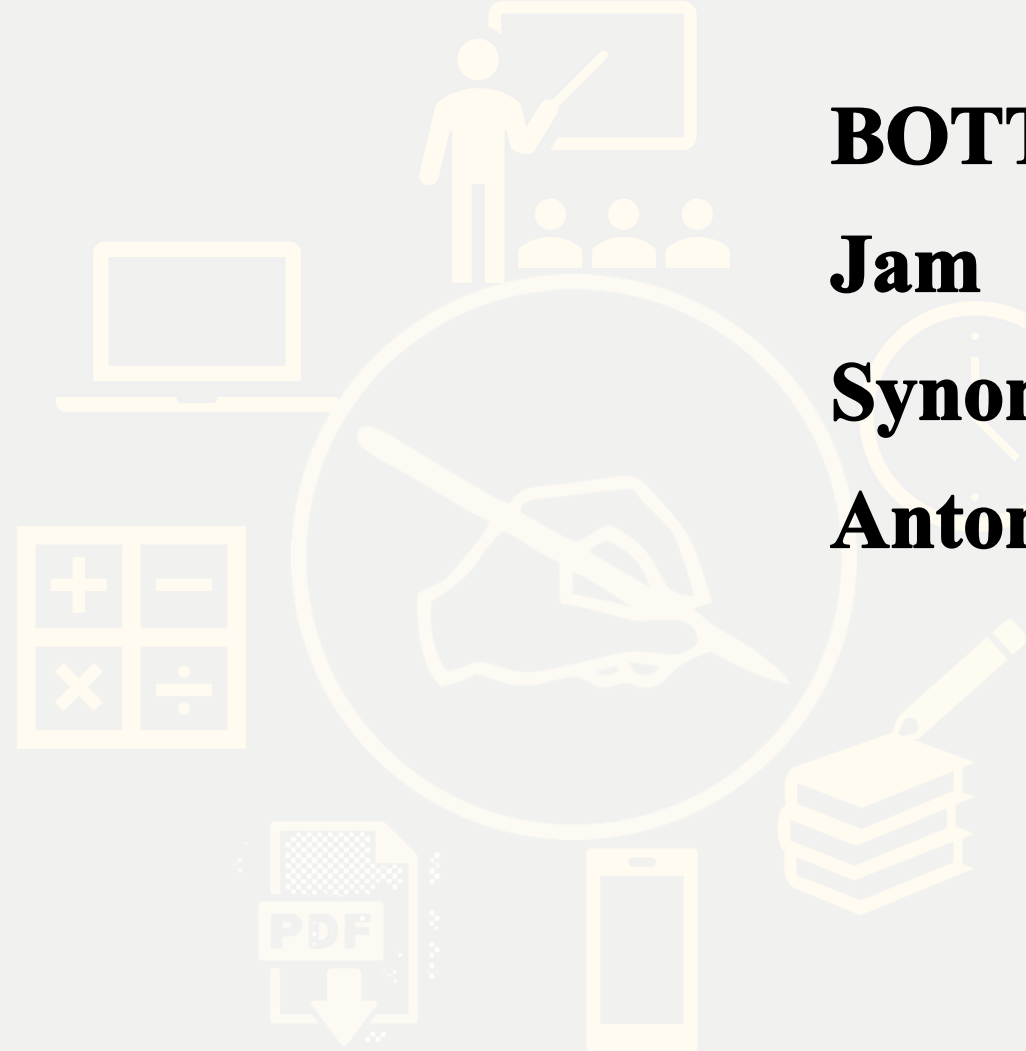

Antonyms: Benign, Beneficial

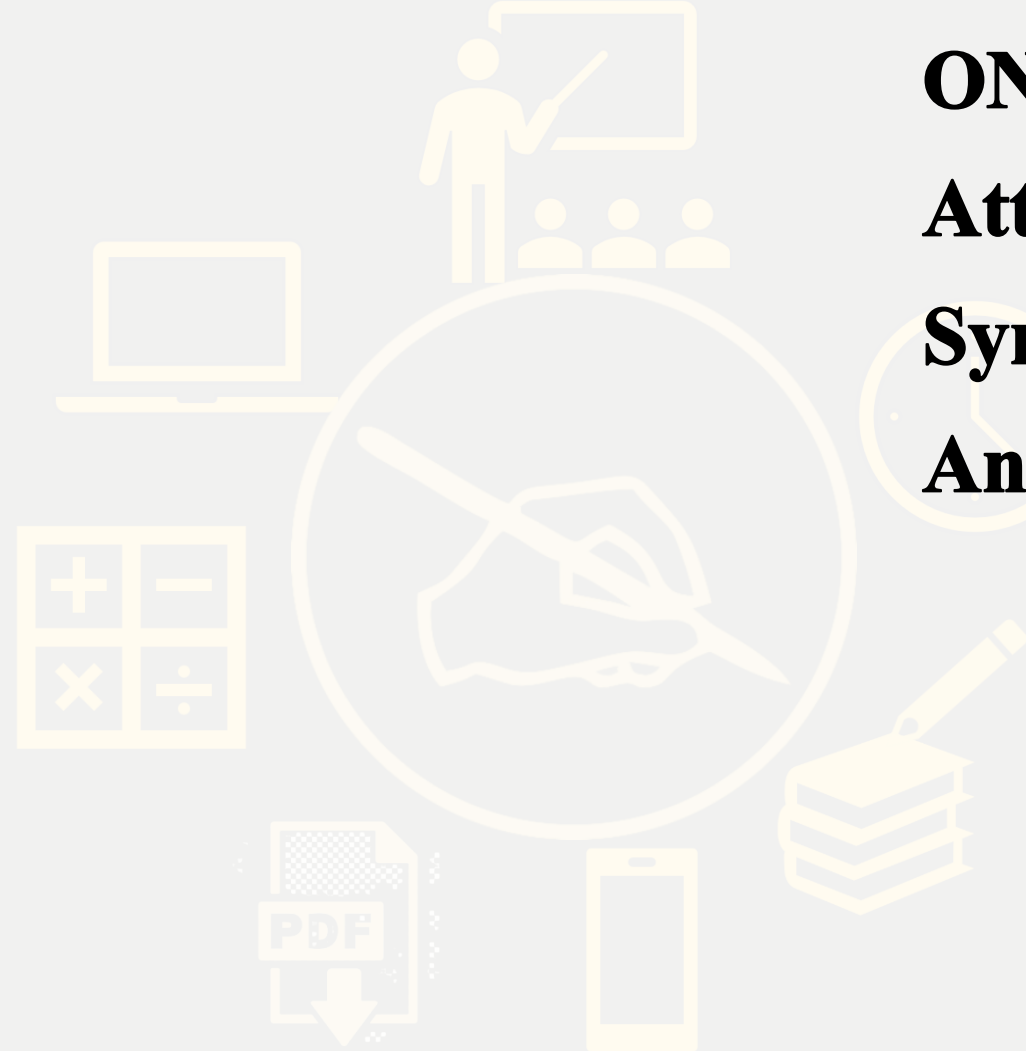


ONSLAUGHT (NOUN): (हमला):
