










India, China agree to restart talks between border commanders









ARTICLE

The officials also agreed that they must "ensure a stable ground situation and avoid any untoward incident" until the situation is resolved. The 13th round of border commander-level talks on October 10 ended with an acrimonious exchange between the two sides.

"It was agreed that both sides should hold the next [14th] round of the Senior Commanders' meeting at an early date to achieve the objective of complete disengagement from all the friction points along the LAC in the western sector in accordance with the existing bilateral agreements and protocols," said the statement issued by the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA)





A statement from New Delhi in October said India had made "constructive suggestions for resolving the remaining areas but the Chinese side was not agreeable and also could not provide any forward-looking proposals".

The Chinese military had laid the blame at India for the stalemate saying it had made "unreasonable and unrealistic demands" and "hoped that the Indian side would avoid misjudging the situation".







