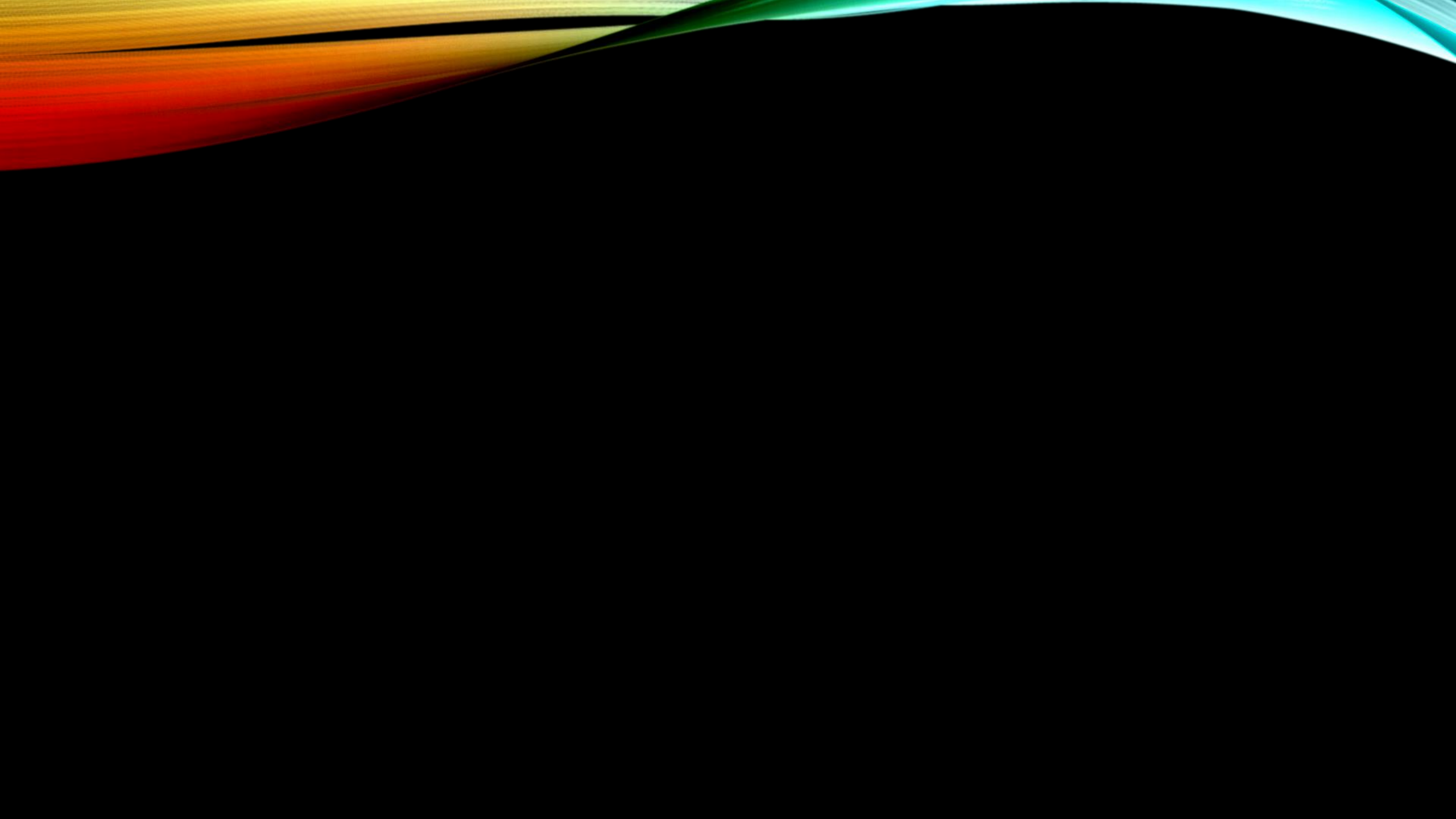

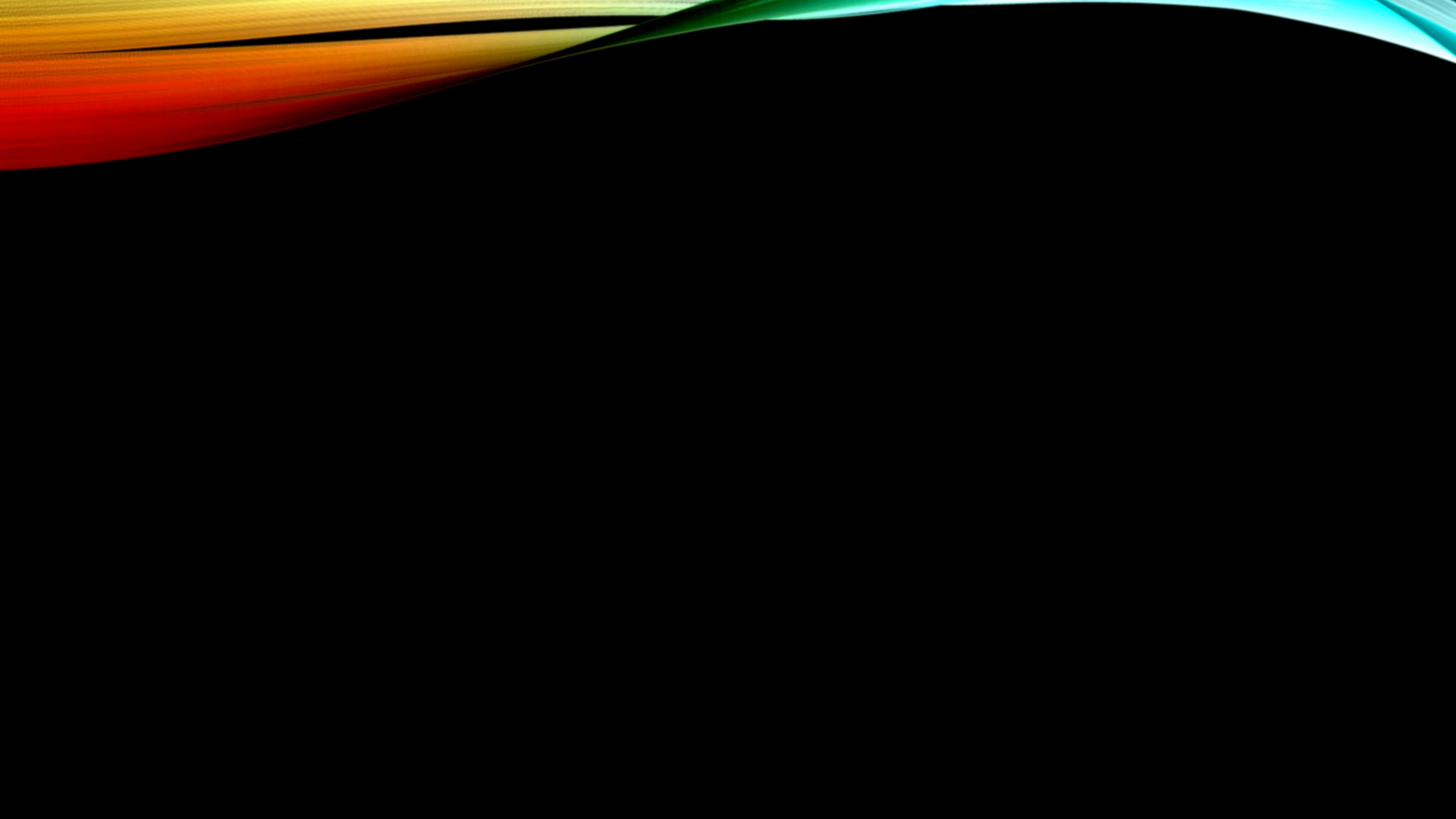

Sentence: The nurse swathed the wounded soldier's
leg in bandages.

Reverberate(Verb) : (ध्वनि का) गूँजना

Meaning : (of sound) to continue to be heard; to echo repeatedly

Synonyms : Resonate , Vibrate

Sentence : The loud music reverberated off the walls.

Inevitable(Adj.) : अनिवार्य

Meaning : Certain to happen and unable to be avoided or prevented

Synonyms: Inescapable , Inexorable

Antonyms : Avoidable , uncertain

Sentence : The accident was the inevitable consequence/result/outcome of carelessness.

Efficacious(Adj.) : प्रभावशाली

Meaning : Capable of having the desired result or effect

Synonyms: Effective , Productive

Antonyms: Impotent , Incapable

Sentence: They resort to any and every agent which has been proved efficacious, whether it be vegetable or mineral.

Curbs(Verb) : नियंत्रण रखना

Meaning : To limit or control something, especially something bad

Synonyms: Limitation , Restrain

Antonyms : Loosen , Liberate
