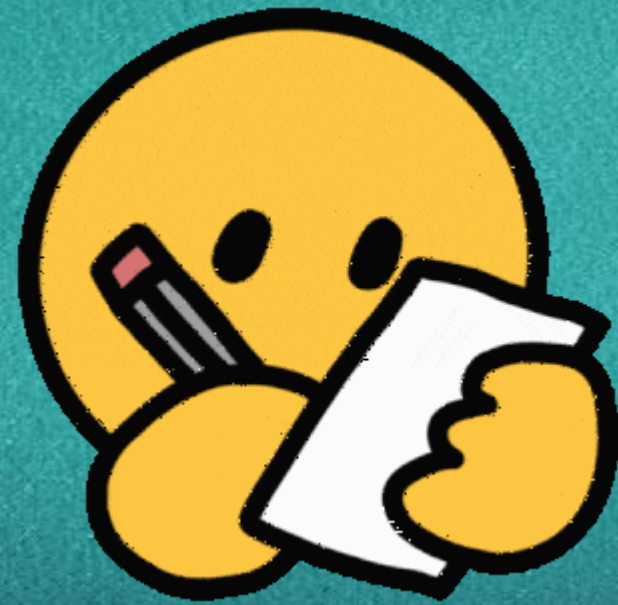
Bedlam
