SUBJECT VERB AGREEMENT PART 1



RULE 1

Words joined to a singular subject by with, together with, in addition to or as well as, etc. are parenthetical, and therefore do not affect the number of the Verb.

FIND ERROR BASED ON CONCEPTS

The Head of the Department, (1)/along with his colleagues are coming (2)/to attend the conference which is (3)/scheduled this afternoon. (4)/ No error (5).

ANSWER : 2

SOLUTION : Replace 'Are' with 'Is'



RULE 2

FIND ERROR BASED ON CONCEPTS

15

1. We padded the seat of the chair with camel hairs to make it soft.

ANSWER : Replace 'HAIRS' with 'HAIR'

EXPLANATION : 'HAIR' is an uncountable noun. So it generally considered singular.





Hair vs Hairs



CAN WE USE HAIRS ?

1. My tea has 3 gray **hairs** in it.
2. His white **hairs** are clearly seen.
3. I just washed my **hair**.
4. Your **hair** is looking beautiful.
5. My mother's **hair** is turning white.



Find the error:

Every girl must bring their own lunch.

Solution : Replace 'their' with 'her'

RULE 3



Every boy and girl were ready.

If the Singular Subjects are preceded by each or every, the Verb is usually Singular.

Solution : Replace 'Was' with 'Were'



Everybody Somebody Nobody Anybody

Everyone Someone Noone Anyone

Everything Something Nothing Anything

RULE 4



**Neither the size nor the colour (1)/of
the clothes which (2)/ I purchased
for him (3)/yesterday were right (4)/
No error (5).**

**Solution : 'Were' will be replaced by
'Was'**



**Two or more
Singular Subjects
connected by or, nor,
either..... or,
neither.... nor take a
Verb in the Singular.**

**Neither he nor I were
there.**

RULE 5



**Neither the Assistant Master
nor the Headmaster was present.**

Solution : Replace 'Were' with 'Was'



**When the Subjects
joined by or/nor are of
different numbers, the
Verb must be Plural,
and the Plural Subject
must be placed next to
the Verb.**

- 1. My aunt or my uncle is
arriving by train today.**
- 2. Neither Juan nor Carmen is
available.**

RULE 6



Ten dollars are a great deal of money to a child.

Solution : Replace 'Are' with "is"



**Expressions
of time,
money and
distance**

Ten kilometres is too far to walk.
Six weeks is not long enough.

RULE 7

Half of *what he writes* are undocumented.



Solution : 'Are' will be replaced by 'Is'



**With fractions,
percentages and
indefinite quantifiers
(*all, few, many, much
, some*)**

- 1. One-third of this article is taken up with statistical analysis.**
- 2. Fifty percent of the job is routine.**
