Countable Nouns

Countable nouns refer to items that can be counted, even if the number might be extraordinarily high (like counting all the people in the world, for example).

Countable nouns can be used with articles such as a/an and the or quantifiers such as a few and many.



Uncountable Nouns

Uncountable nouns, or mass nouns, are nouns that come in a state or quantity that is impossible to count; liquids are uncountable, as are things that act like liquids (sand, air). Abstract ideas like creativity or courage are also uncountable.

Uncountable nouns are always considered to be singular, and can stand alone or be used with some, any, a little, and much.


SINGULAR NOUN

A **Singular noun** refers to a single object , it can also be used to refer to places , things or ideas. Singular nouns always use a singular verb and can be preceded by the articles a and an.



PLURAL NOUN

Plural nouns are nouns that refer to more than one person, place, or thing. In general, plural nouns are made by adding -s or -es to the ends of singular nouns. However, this isn't always the case. Sometimes a noun may change spelling or may turn into a completely different word. Plural nouns always use a plural verb in a sentence and aren't preceded by the articles a and an.



RULE 1

1. The scissors are a portable tool to be carried away easily.

2. My goggles are very expensive that I bought from Bangalore.

There are certain nouns which are always used in the plural forms. You can never remove S at the last to use it singular. These seem plural, are used too.

Scissors, Tongs, Pliers, Pincers, Bellows, Trousers, Pants, Pajamas, Shorts, Gallows, Fangs, Spectacles, Goggles, Binoculars, Eyeglasses, Alms, Amends, Archives, Arrears, Congratulations, Outskirts, Riches, surroundings, Thanks and Belongings etc.



RULE 2

- 1. Physics was my favorite subject till 9th grade**
- 2. Sachin Tendulkar scored a century in a single innings against the Shri Lanka team in the world cup.**

Some nouns may look plural, but are actually singular in reality. We always use singular verb with such nouns. News, Innings, Politics, Summons, Physics, Economics, Ethics, Mathematics, Mumps, Rickets, Billiards, Athletics.



RULE 3

- 1. My hair is very long, but I never feel like having a haircut.**
- 2. He leaks the personal information and sells it to the enemy country.**

There are some uncountable nouns which are always used a singular, but we can't use A/an article with them. Scenery, Poetry, Furniture, Advice, Information, Hair, Business, Bread, Stationery, Crockery, Luggage, Baggage, Knowledge, Wastage, Jewellery, Breakage, Work, Evidence and Cost.



RULE 4

- 1. I have 3 dozen bananas with me.**
- 2. My school is several kilometres away from my home.**

Some nouns imply the number, measure, money, length, weight, etc. When a definite numeral comes before these nouns, they remain singular, and when an indefinite numeral is used they become plural.



RULE 5

The bug is coming and going in the room.

The baby is crying since we boarded the train.

The neuter gender is used when referring to small animals, insects, or very young children.



RULE 6

In spite of referring to living beings, collective nouns are treated as neuter gender and are followed by the pronoun “it” mostly.

- 1. The army is preparing for its exercise.**
- 2. The band has got its first contract.**
