




• Tributories :- Rangit, Jaldhaka, Kalijhora, Lish, Gish, Karola • Its the third largest river of West Bengal




MAHANANDA


- 358 KM

Tributories:- Rang, Bang (right side), Ring, Tong, Ching, Khola



- Falling point:- Joined with second Raidhak, Kaljani then fall in Brahmaputra river



ATREYEE

- Source:- After flowing through Bangladesh's Jaiganj, Birganj, Kotwali it enters WB in South Dinajpur district
- Falling Point:- Barabal (Branch river of Padma) in Bangladesh
- Tributories:- Icchamati
- Balurghat city is situated at the bank of this river.
