2. EXPLICATE (VERB) : (समझाना) : explain

Synonyms: clarify, spell out

**Antonyms: obscure** 

Example Sentence: An attempt was made to explicate the relationship between crime and justice.

3. RESOLUTION (NOUN) : (प्रण) : determination

Synonyms: purpose, resolve

**Antonyms: irresolution** 

Example Sentence: He handled the last British actions of the war with resolution.
