### ⇒ Vocab of the day :-

1. **ABEYANCE (NOUN)** : (निलम्बन) : suspension

Synonyms: suspense, remission

Antonyms: in hand

Example Sentence: Matters were held in abeyance pending further enquiries.

2. **EXPLICATE (VERB)** : (समझाना) : explain

Synonyms: clarify, spell out

Antonyms: obscure

Example Sentence: An attempt was made to explicate the relationship between crime and justice.

3. **RESOLUTION (NOUN)** : (प्रण) : determination

Synonyms: purpose, resolve

Antonyms: irresolution

Example Sentence: He handled the last British actions of the war with resolution.
