






PARTS OF INDIAN CONSTITUTION

The original text of the Indian Constitution consisted of 22 parts and after amendments, currently, it contains 25 parts. The 25 parts of the Indian Constitution are tabled below:











Parts of the Indian Constitution added as amendments

- Part IV-A and Part XIV-A were added by 42nd Constitutional amendment Act 1976
- Part IX-A (Municipalities) were added by 74th C.A. Act 1992, Part IX-B (Co-operative societies) are added by 97th C.A. act 2011 to the original constitution.

• Part VII Repealed by Con, (7th Amendment) Act, 1956





Which are the schedules of the Indian Constitution?

Schedules are basically tables which contains additional details not mentioned in the articles. (395)

Indian Constitution originally had eight schedules.

Four more schedules were added by different amendments, now making a total tally of twelve.








Schedules of Indian Constitution-

THE SECOND SCHEDULE contains provisions relating to the empluments, allowances, privileges and so on of the President, Governors of States, Speaker and the Deputy Speaker of the House of the People and the Chairman and the Deputy Chairman of the Council of States and the Speaker and the Deputy Speaker of the Legislative Assembly and the Chairman and the Deputy Chairman of the Legislative Council of a State, the Judges of the Supreme Court and of the High Courts and the Comptroller and Auditor-General of India.
