Vocab of the day

⇒ Vocab of the day :-

(1) **LIGHT-HEARTED (ADJECTIVE)** : (प्रसन्नचित) : carefree

Synonyms: cheerful, cheery

Antonyms: miserable

Example Sentence: We had an excited, light-hearted chatter.

(2) **ACCREDIT (VERB)** : (मान्यता देना) : recognize

Synonyms: license, authorize

Antonyms: ban

Example Sentence: Institutions that do not meet the standards will not be accredited for teacher training.

(3) **PROTRACT (VERB)** : (बढ़ाना) : prolong

Synonyms: extend, draw out

Antonyms: curtail

Example Sentence: He had certainly taken his time, even protracting the process.
