### > Vocab of the day :-

1. NULLIFY (VERB) : (अमान्य ठहराना) : annul

Synonyms: void, invalidate

**Antonyms: ratify** 

**Example Sentence: Judges were unwilling to nullify government decisions.** 

2. VEHEMENCE (NOUN) : (जुनून) : passion

Synonyms: force, ardour

**Antonyms: apathy** 

**Example Sentence: There was a lot of vehemence in his reaction.** 

3. CHASM (NOUN) : (गहरी खाई) : gap

Synonyms: crater, rift

Antonyms: closure, juncture

**Example Sentence: The chasm between the rich and poor has grown** 

wider over the last decade.
