Mr. Bialiatski was jailed / between 2011 to 2014 by the / regime of Aleksandr / Lukashenko / no error .

Ans :- use “from” in place of between .

When street protests broke out along / the country in 2020 after the disputed presidential election / in which Mr. Lukashenko “won” a sixth term, authorities / arrested Mr. Bialiatski again. / no error .

Ans:- use “across” in place of along ..

Last year, the NGO was disband by / a Moscow court and last week, a judge / ruled in favour of the seizure / of the organisation's office by the authorities / no error

Ans :- Use “disbanded”

CCL, founded in 2007, risen to prominence / in Ukraine's 2014 pro-western Maidan protests / that brought down the pro-Russian /government of Viktor Yanukovich. / no error .

Ans :- rose "in place of " risen
