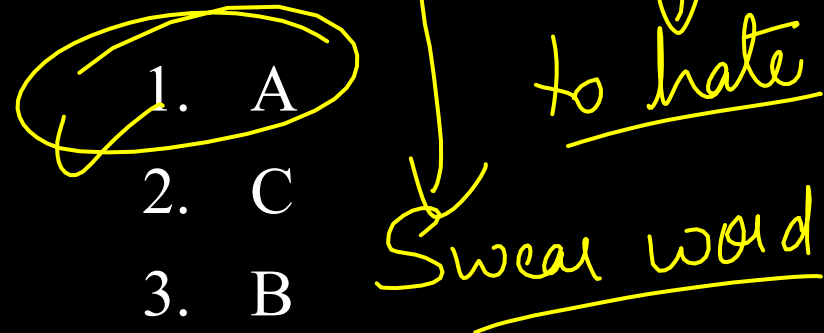

- A. Dry compasses began appearing around 1300 in Medieval Europe and the Medieval Islamic world. **FDB4CAE.**
- B. The compass was later used for navigation during the Chinese Song Dynasty (960–1279 AD), as described by Shen Kuo.
- C. Magnetized needles and compasses were first described in medieval Europe by the English theologian Alexander Neckam (1157–1217 AD).
- D. Later compasses were made of iron needles, magnetized by striking them with a lodestone.** *Homework*
- E. The first compasses were made of lodestone, a naturally magnetized stone of iron, in Han dynasty China (202 BC – 220 AD).
- F. This was replaced in the early 20th century by the liquid-filled magnetic compass.
- G. The compass was invented more than 2,000 years ago.
