

Sentence : He was so boisterous at the party that he stole the thunder from the hosts.

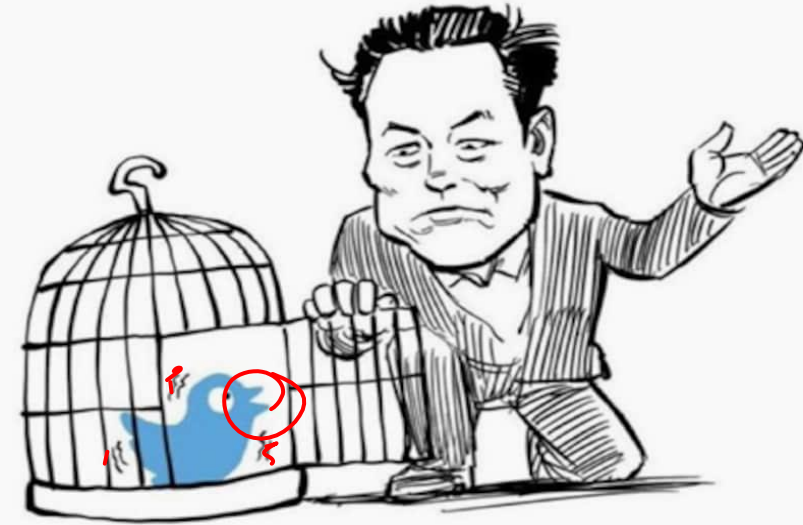
Meaning : Noisy and full of energy

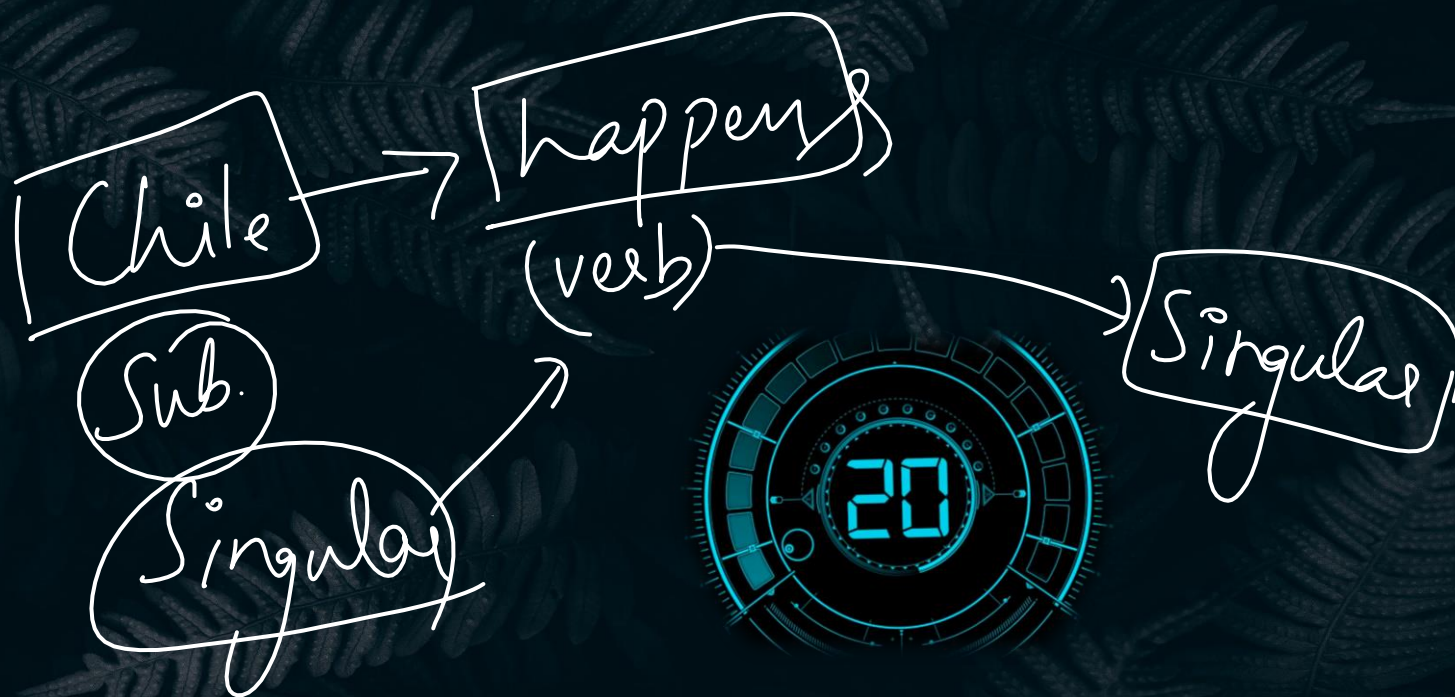
