- ◆ **SSC CGL 2022 :-** The SSC CGL exam 2022 recruitment is expected to start from September 10th 2022. The Staff Selection Commission through its official exam calendar has announced the date for SSC CGL 2022 recruitment.
- ◆ **Nationality:-** Candidates must be nationals of India, Nepal, Bhutan
- ◆ **Essential Qualifications 2022 :-** Bachelor's Degree from a recognized University or Institute.

Penalty of Wrong Answer :-In Tier-II, there will be negative marking of 0.25 for each wrong answer in Paper-II (English Language and Comprehension) and of 0.50 marks for each wrong answer in Paper-I, Paper-III and Paper-IV.

◇ **Note :-**

◇ In Tier-II, Paper-I and Paper-II are compulsory for all the posts.

◇ In Tier-II, Paper-III will be for only those candidates who apply for the posts of Junior Statistical Officer (JSO) in the Ministry of Statistics and Programmer Implementation and Statistical Investigator Grade-II in the office of Registrar General of India (M/o Home Affairs) and who are shortlisted in Tier-I for these Posts.

◇ In Tier-II, Paper-IV will be for only those candidates who are shortlisted in Tier-I Tier-I for Paper-IV i.e. for the posts of Assistant Audit Officer/ Assistant Accounts Officer.



SSC CGL Tier-III: Pattern

- ◇ Mode of Examination :- Pen and Paper mode
- ◇ Scheme of Examination :- Descriptive Paper in English or Hindi
(Writing of Essay/Precis/Letter/Application etc.)
- ◇ Maximum Marks :- 100
- ◇ Time Allowed :- 1 hour



SSC CGL Tier-IV: Pattern

- ◆ In the Tier-IV, Computer Proficiency Test (CPT) and Data Entry Speed Test (DEST) will be conducted. This exam will be done to evaluate a candidate's typing and basic computer-related skills.
- ◆ The “Data Entry Speed Test” Skill Test will be conducted for a passage of about 2000 (two thousand) key depressions for a duration of 15 (fifteen) minutes.

- ◆ Those candidates writing the SSC CHSL Exam this year must thoroughly understand the eligibility criteria. The SSC CHSL Eligibility criteria are as follows:
- ◆ Nationality: Candidates must be nationals of India, Nepal, Bhutan
- ◆ Age Limit: Candidates must be between the age group of 18 years to 27 years.
- ◆ Qualifications: Candidates must be 12th pass or equivalent from a recognized board of a university.
