ACTIVE & PASSIVE VOICE



Active voice: In active sentences, the subject is active or the subject performs the actions.
e.g. The cow (Subject) is eating (Verb) grass (Object).—Active Voice

Passive voice: In passive sentences, the subject is no longer active or the subject is acted upon by the verb e.g. Grass (Subject) is being eaten (Verb)
