Ans: (3) It is Preposition related error.

Ans: (1) It is Preposition related error. Hence, peace of mind is the right usage.

Ans: (1) brood (V) is the right word that will be used here. (1) brood (V) : to worry ; to think a lot about something that makes you annoyed, anxious/upset Hence, to brood over is the right usage.
