*'Helping verbs' are used before action or linking verbs to convey additional information regarding aspects of possibility (can, could, etc.) or time (was, did, has, etc.)*

## IMPORTANT CONCEPTS OF VERB

### MODAL VERBS

#### Can, Could - 1) *Be Able To*

- Tom can write poetry very well.*
- I can not help you by next week.*
- When I was a child I could climb trees.*

#### 2) *Make a suggestion*

*You could take the tour of the castle tomorrow.*



## *Possibility / Impossibility*

- You can catch that train at 10:43.*
- I could fly via Amsterdam if I leave the day before.*

## *Ask Permission / Give Permission*

- Can you lend me ten dollars?*
- You can borrow my car.*
- Could I have your number?*



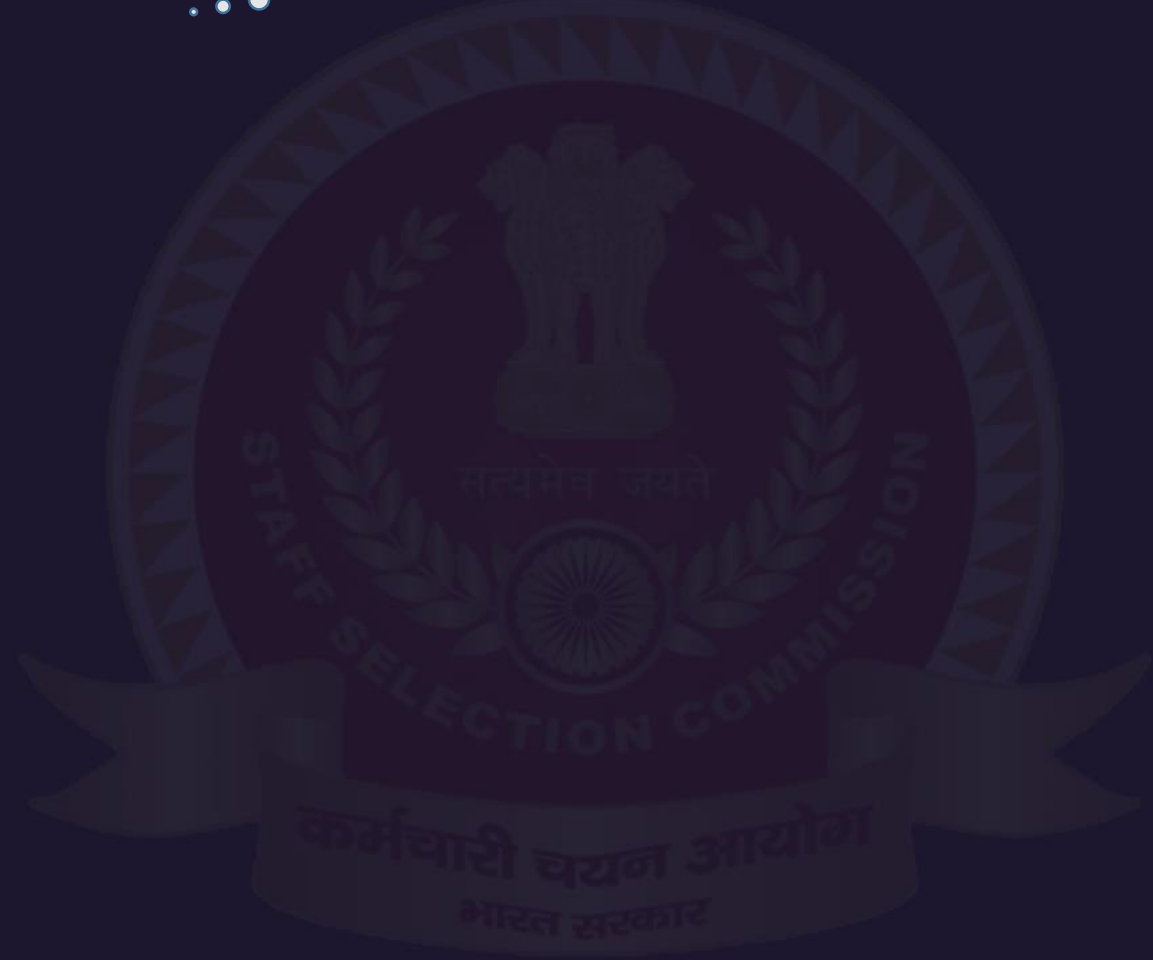

*To Offer of Assistance or Polite Suggestion (When you are quite sure of a positive answer)*

**Shall we go for a walk?**

*To Offer of Assistance or Polite Suggestion (When you are not sure of a positive answer)*

**Should I call a doctor?**





***A Prediction or Expectation  
that Something Will Happen***

- The proposal should be finished on time.*
- I shouldn't be late. The train usually arrives on time.*

***To Give Advice***

- You should check that document before you send it out.*
- You ought to have your car serviced before the winter*

***To Give Advice (about  
something you think wrong or  
unacceptable)***

- James shouldn't teach him words like those.*



## ***WILL / WOULD***

***Polite Request or Statement***

- Will you please take the trash out?***
- Would you mind if I sat here?***

***Habitual Past Action***

- When I was a child, I would spend hours playing with my train set.***





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– MAY & MIGHT

*Formal Permission*  
*Formal Prohibition*

- You may start your exam now.
- You may not wear sandals to work.

*Polite Request*

- May I help you?

*Possibility / Negative Possibility*

- We may go out for dinner tonight.
- Our company might get the order if the client agrees to the price.

- You might like to try pizza ,it's our special today .***
