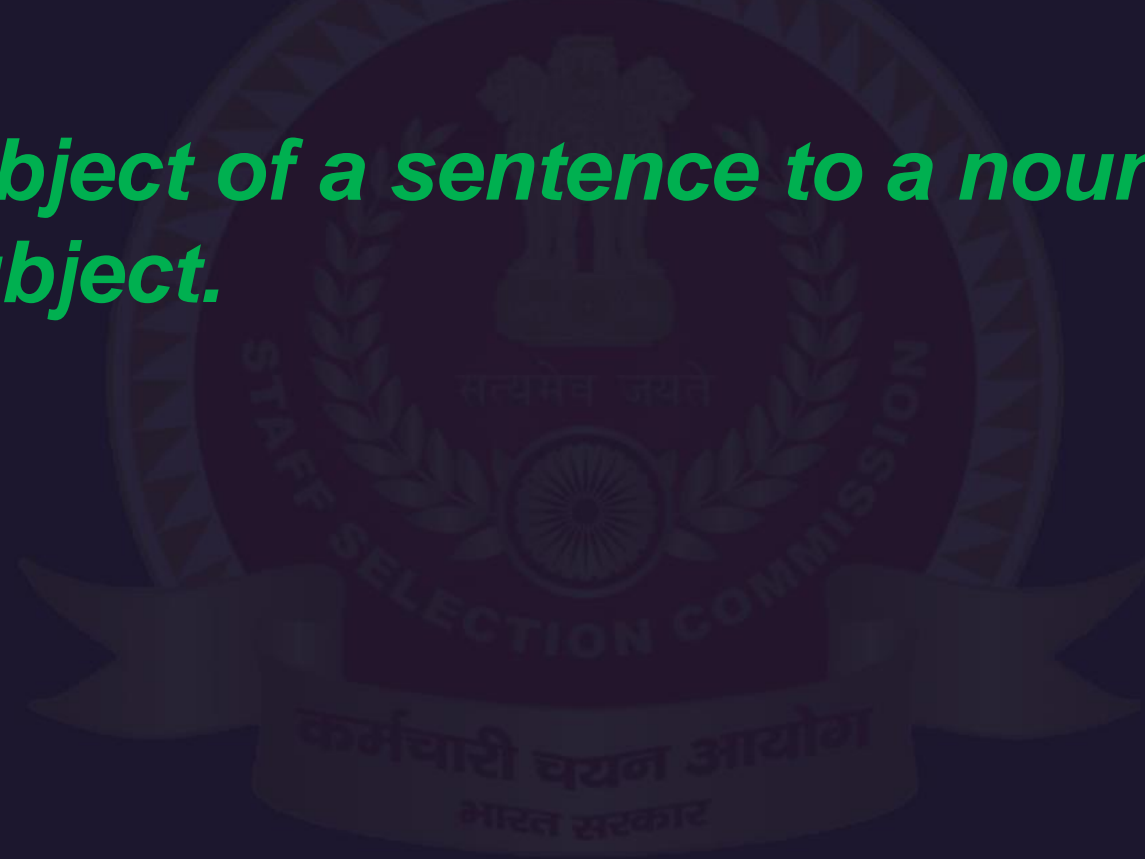

IMPORTANT CONCEPTS OF VERB

LINKING VERBS – *No action .*

Connects the subject of a sentence to a noun or adjective that describes the subject.





IMPORTANT CONCEPTS OF VERB

Dynamic/Action Verbs:

Action verbs are words that express action (give, eat, walk, etc.) or possession (have, own, etc.).

1) Transitive Verb

2) Intransitive Verb

IMPORTANT CONCEPTS OF VERB

Transitive Verbs:

A transitive verb always has a noun that receives the action of the verb, called the direct object/indirect object.

Ex: *Pollard raises her hand. s*
 Abdul gave Vicky the pencil.

Intransitive Verbs:

An intransitive verb never has a direct or indirect object. Although an intransitive verb may be followed by an adverb or adverbial phrase, there is no object to receive its action.

Ex : *The bell rings.*
