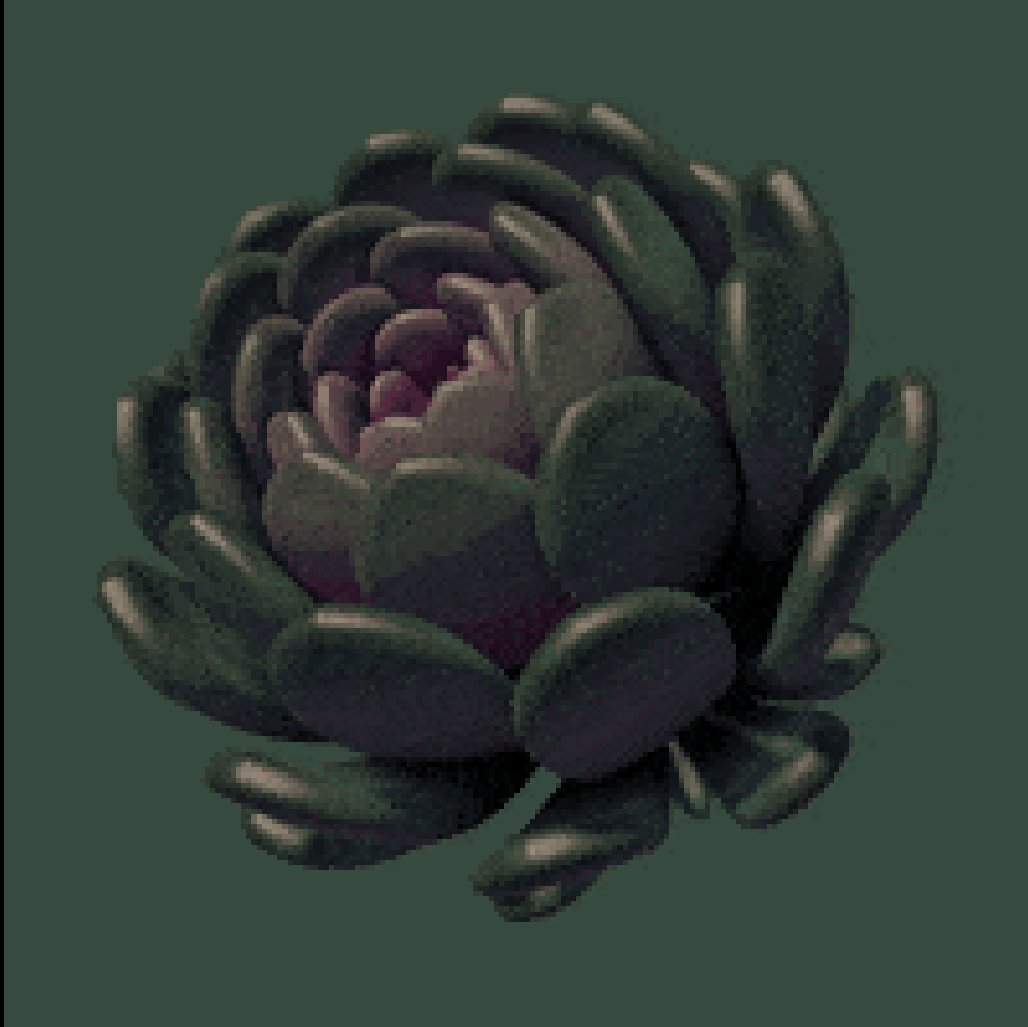
UNFURLING

HARKS

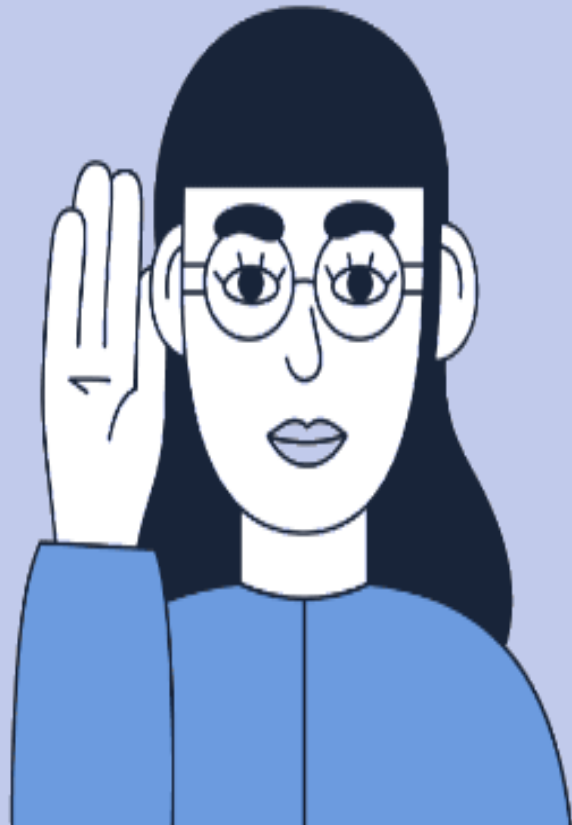
Meaning : **Listens attentively or pays heed to something.**
