

Congress a combination of plunder, deceit, says Modi

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Saturday described the Congress as a combination of "plunder and deceit" and said people would vote out the party-led government in Rajasthan in the Assembly election as it is "neither honest nor stable".

"There is only one meaning of the Congress: loot ki dukaan and jhooth ka bazaar," Mr. Modi said in an apparent reference to Congress leader Rahul Gandhi's oft-repeated remark that his party is 'mohabbat ki dukaan' (shop of affection) in 'nafrat ka bazaar' (market of hatred).

The Prime Minister was addressing a BJP rally at Naurangdesar village in Bikaner district after dedicating and laying the founda-

tion stones of development projects worth more than ₹24,300 crore.

Mr. Modi said the public anger against the Congress government had increased so much that it would take no time to unseat it. The defeat of the Congress was so certain that the Ministers and MLAs had started vacating their government bungalows, he said, adding that the ruling party had caused "significant harm" to the State over the past

four and a half years.

Mr. Modi said the Congress – plagued with internal rift and dissension – had promoted corruption, crime and politics of appeasement. "Under the Congress rule, protectors have become predators... Rajasthan tops the list in crimes against women. The entire government machinery here is busy in protecting rape and murder accused," he said.

Projects unveiled

Mr. Modi earlier dedicated to the people a six-lane greenfield expressway section of the Amritsar-Jamnagar Economic Corridor, phase 1 of the Inter-State Transmission Line for Green Energy Corridor, a Bikaner-to-Bhiwadi power transmission line and an Employees' State Insurance Corporation Hospital.

Question Corner

The paradox

When foraging together, do elephants get enough to eat?

We know that elephants eat plants. An earlier study found that elephants switch from eating fresh grasses when it rains to eating trees during the long dry season. In a recent study (Royal Society Open Science), researchers showed that dietary differences among individuals were often far greater than it had been previously assumed, even among family members that foraged together on a given day. The study helps address a classic paradox in wildlife ecology. Given that elephants all seemingly eat the same

plants, it's not obvious why competition for food doesn't push them apart and force them to forage independently. The simple answer is that elephants vary their diets based not only on what's available but also their preferences and physiological needs, as per a release. These findings help inform theories of why a group of elephants may forage together: the individual elephants don't always eat exactly the same plants at the same time, so there will usually be enough plants to go around.

Warkaris walk 250 km to worship Lord Vitthal at Pandharpur in Maharashtra with faith and joy during their annual pilgrimage

hey chant, they dance, they walk. Tens of thousands of pilgrims called "warkaris" undertake on foot the journey to honour the deity Vitthal, also known as Vithoba, at Pandharpur in Maharashtra every year. The pilgrimage that can span 21 days is known as Dindi.

The pilgrimage culminates on Ashadhi Ekadashi, which fell on June 29 this year.

The tradition goes back 700 to 800 years.

Though the origin of the pilgrimage is not clear, various theories credit its growth to Viththalpant Kulkarni (father of Saint Dnyaneshwar), Saint Dnyaneshwar, Saint Tukaram and Narayan Maharaj (youngest son of saint Tukaram).

The word warkari is explained as a combination of two words. War is an abbreviation of wari, which means pilgrimage, and kari is the one who performs the pilgrimage.

The pilgrimages that originate from the shrines of saints Dnyaneshwar and Tukaram are the most famous, particularly because they have the largest number of participants.

The pilgrims walk a distance of about 250 km in three weeks covering the districts of Pune, Satara and Solapur. Along the way, they chant the Lord's name (nam japa), sing holy songs (abhang) and read sacred texts (haripath).
