# VOCABULARY



## **PROACTIVE(ADJ.)**

**Meaning: taking initiative and acting in anticipation of future events or problems, rather than just reacting to situations.**

**Synonym: Anticipatory , Initiative**

**Antonym: Passive , Lethargic**

**Example Sentence: Jane's proactive approach to her work, where she constantly seeks out new opportunities and addresses potential issues before they arise, has made her a valuable asset to the team.**



## REPATRIATES(noun)

**Meaning:** individuals who have returned to their own country, especially after a period of living or working abroad.

**Synonyms:** Returnees , Resettles

**Antonyms:** Migrants , Expatriates

**Example Sentence:**

The government provided support and assistance to the repatriates who had spent years working overseas, helping them reintegrate into their home country

## SUCCOUR(noun)

Meaning: assistance, support, or help provided in times of difficulty, distress, or need.

Synonyms: comfort, help

Antonyms: Neglect, Abandonment

Example Sentence: During the natural disaster, the local community rallied together to provide succour to the affected families, offering food, shelter, and emotional support.



## **PETITIONER (NOUN)**

**Meaning: an individual or group of people who formally make a request or plea**

**Synonyms: Suit , Pleader , Solicitor**

**Antonyms: Opponent , Respondent**

**Example Sentence: The petitioner submitted a well-documented plea to the city council, urging them to address the environmental concerns in their neighborhood.**





## REFUGEE (NOUN)

**Meaning:** a person who has been forced to leave their home country due to war, persecution, or natural disaster and has sought refuge in another country.

**Synonyms:** Evacuee, Fugitive, Exile

**Antonyms:** Native, citizen

**Example Sentence:**

The humanitarian organization provided shelter, food, and medical assistance to the refugees fleeing the conflict zone, offering them a temporary place of safety and support



## NON-REFOULEMENT (NOUN)

**Meaning:** a principle in international law that prohibits the expulsion, deportation, or forced return of individuals to a country where they may face persecution, torture, or other forms of harm.

**Synonyms:** no expulsion, Non-return

**Example Sentence:**

The international community upholds the principle of non-refoulement to ensure that individuals seeking asylum are not sent back to situations where their lives or freedoms are at risk.
